Rationalization of players & player lists

- Decision to do one more net (26th Oct) at the India Club with the next one on the next Saturday afternoon (7th Nov) at Neil's place - complete with bowling machine, in Big Wave Bay.

Women's Team

The League schedule has been redone again and the first game is in December.

Ian Harling raised concerns over the sustainability of Lamma CC's women's team.

Mark Burns offered to get an update from the women's team and report back at the next meeting.

HKU Sixes Event

A Lamma CC team was entered in the HKU Sixes event on 17th Oct and only three players turned up. One player contacted me after we were already knocked out and have still not heard from the other 2 players. It cost the Club money, but far more importantly was our reputation being damaged and penalties have been handed out to the players.

Membership Committee

- This committee to be comprised of at least 2 life members and one or two others from the Executive Committee.
